FRANKIE WORKERS LAUNCH



The Frankie Worker scheme was launched on Thursday 6h July; the service will offer therapeutic counselling to children and young people aged up to 18 years who have been traumatised as a result of child sexual abuse, CSE, or are a victim of FGM. Frankie Workers will provide proper support for children and young people to prevent trauma turning into poor mental health issues.
