CONTRACTS & GRANTS

What is the difference between Contracts and Grants?

Essential, larger, unlikely to change substantially

14 contracts total value of £2,544,363

For example, the Victim Care Service has supported over 190k victims of crime in Hampshire policing area

Small scale, local, voluntary

33 grants funded October 2018 – September 2019 total value of £341,965

65 grants funded April 2019 – March 2020 total value of £1,291,041

April - £50,000 Maximum per Application

October - £15,000 Maximum per Application
