

## **EDUCATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE**

### **Terms of Reference (Revised)**

1. The Education Advisory Panel is an Advisory Panel made up of 9 Members appointed proportionally and meeting three times a year towards the end of each school term. The Panel is chaired by the relevant Executive Member and its function is to advise the Executive Member in relation to:
  - (ii) Educational Outcomes of children and young people, including vulnerable children and young people, aged 0-19.
  - (iii) Excellent and innovative practise in educational settings from which others can learn.
  - (iv) To advise the Executive Member regarding significant changes to Education proposed both nationally and locally.
  
2. The Education Advisory Panel will also comprise seven co-opted members as follows:
  - (i) The Director of Education for the Portsmouth and Winchester Diocese.
  - (ii) The Director of Education for the Catholic Diocese.
  - (iii) Two representatives of the Hampshire Teachers' Liaison Panel (HTLP), which represents various teaching associations, proposed by the Secretary of the HTLP.
  - (iv) A Primary School Headteacher nominated by the Primary School Headteachers' Executive.
  - (v) A Secondary School Headteacher nominated by the Secondary School Headteachers' Executive.
  - (vi) A Special School Headteacher nominated by the Special School Headteachers' Executive.
