### 1. The decision:

- 1.1. That the Executive Member for Economy, Transport and Environment approves spend from the Structural Maintenance budget of £407,340 to enable Millway Bridge Andover to be brought up to 40t capacity during Network Rail's refurbishment of the bridge, as set out in the supporting report.
- 1.2. That approval be given to spend and enter into the necessary contractual arrangements, including any funding agreements that may be necessary, with Network Rail.
- 1.3. That authority to make the arrangements to implement contracts, including minor variations, be delegated to the Director of Economy, Transport and Environment in consultation with the Head of Legal Services.

### 2. Reason for the decision:

- 2.1. The reason for this decision is to authorise spend to ensure Millway Bridge is brought up to 40t capacity, ensuring the highway carried remains open and unrestricted.

### 3. Other options considered and rejected:

- 3.1. Network Rail's work could proceed without strengthening to 40t, but this would lead to a weight restriction and/or carriageway restrictions, which would create a long term constraint and maintenance liability for Hampshire County Council.
