# Attainment in Hampshire Schools 2020

- KS2 tests cancelled
- GCSEs cancelled
- A levels cancelled

There is no official data showing the attainment of pupils in 2020 at a school, local authority or national level



Schools were closed in March with no notice. There was no time for pupils to sit tests or compete extra work.

Any GCSE grading process needed to:

- reflect work to date
- be fair
- be accurate and robust
