Reasons Why this Report is Not for Publication

Executive Summary

3. This report seeks authority to enter into the Section 106 Agreement relating to the planning consent for the redevelopment of the former Addenbrooke care home site in Gosport for a new 60-unit Extra Care scheme.

Contextual Information

- 4. Addenbrooke closed in 2012, and the site is currently vacant.
- An OJEU compliant open market tender for the development and operation of three Extra Care housing schemes, Lot 2 of which was Addenbrooke, was undertaken in April 2018.
- 6. The Executive Member for Policy and Resources approved the award of the tender, as set out in the EMPR report dated 26 September 2018.
- The developer has since progressed the planning application for the 60-unit Extra Care scheme, and the Local Planning Authority (LPA), Gosport Borough Council, passed a resolution to grant planning permission on 22 July 2020.

Section 106 Agreement

- 8. The Section 106 Agreement secures planning obligations in respect of the redevelopment of the Addenbrooke site for Extra Care housing. The committee report of the LPA recommended the grant of planning subject to a Section 106 Agreement relating to:
 - Affordable housing

- Nitrates mitigation
- Contribution towards Public Open Space
- Recreational disturbance contribution
- Traffic Regulation Order
- 9. The Section 106 Agreement will be entered into by the County Council as landowner so as to bind its freehold interest in the land. The nitrate mitigation works also impact upon the existing Nursing Home at Hawthorne Court (owned by the County Council) which will have improved water management controls installed as part of the nitrates mitigation works required to mitigate the development.
- 10. The Section 106 Agreement has been approved by Hampshire Legal Services.
