PART I

1. Hampshire Minerals and Waste Plan Development Scheme

- 1.1. The Hampshire Minerals and Waste Plan is a statutory planning document which is prepared and adopted by a partnership of the relevant Minerals and Waste Planning Authorities. Part I, Chapter 4 of the Constitution requires that approval of the Hampshire Minerals and Waste Plan is a function reserved to the full Council. The Hampshire Minerals and Waste Development Scheme is part of the Hampshire Minerals and Waste Plan.
- 1.2. On 21 June 2022 Cabinet received a report asking Cabinet to recommend to the full Council approval of the Hampshire Minerals and Waste Development Scheme – Update, setting out a revised timetable for the partial update of the Hampshire Minerals and Waste Plan, which comes into effect from July 2022.
