# Results 2022

We have asked schools to send us headline data for Attainment 8 and for the Basics in English and maths.

- **Attainment 8:** this measure averages the performance of individual children in a range of 8 subjects, that must include the core subjects of English, maths and science
- **Basics in English and maths:** this measure shows the percent of the children in the cohort that achieved a grade 4 or above in maths and in either one of English literature or language, or a grade 5 or above calculated the same way.

We collate this data into LA **provisional** headlines that are ready to share soon after results day – subject to enough schools submitting returns. Schools submit this initial provisional data on the condition that that it's **ONLY** used for amalgamation into headlines.

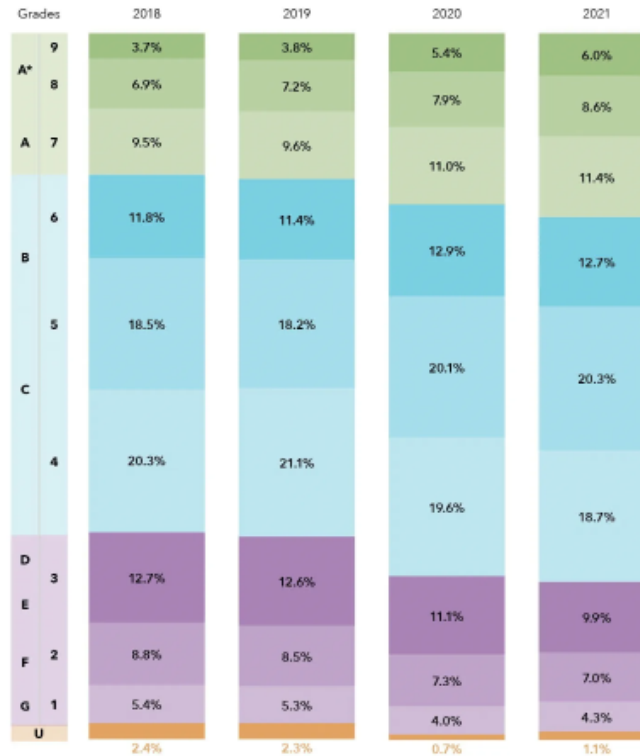

# Results 2022

Published finalised data should be available in draft format in October 2022 and final format in January 2023

- Lots of very complex **counting** issues that might inadvertently compromise published results

We recognise the uneven impact on schools and colleges of the pandemic, and will ensure clear messages are placed on performance tables to **advise caution when considering the 2021/22 data**. This will include **strongly discouraging** all users of the data from drawing **comparisons** with performance data from **previous years**. We will also advise **caution** when **comparing a school's performance** with **national or local authority averages, or with other schools**.
