RESPONSIBILITIES FOR EXECUTIVE FUNCTIONS AND SELECT COMMITTEE FUNCTIONS

1. Responsibility for Executive Functions

- 1.1. Part I, Chapter 17, Paragraph 1.3 of the Constitution requires that changes to the Constitution consequential upon the allocation of responsibility for Executive Functions as determined by the Leader, be reported to Cabinet and then full Council.
- 1.2. The Leader has determined for clarity that it would be helpful to include more detail in the Constitution regarding the portfolios of the Leader and Executive Member for Policy, Resources and Economic Development, and the Executive Member for Commercial Strategy, Estates and Property. The Leader has also determined that the title of the portfolio of the Executive Member Recreation, Heritage and Rural Affairs should instead read Executive Member Countryside, Culture and Communities.
- 1.3. Details of revised Executive Functions are contained at **Appendix 1**.

2. Responsibility for Select Committee Functions

- 2.1. Consequential upon the revised title of the portfolio of the Executive Member Countryside, Culture and Communities, it is appropriate that the Culture and Communities Select Committee be renamed to read Countryside, Culture and Communities Select Committee.

RECOMMENDATIONS

That the County Council:

- a) Notes the revisions to the Executive portfolios of Leader and Executive Member for Policy, Resources and Economic Development, and the Executive Member for Commercial Strategy, Estates and Property.
- b) Agrees that the Culture and Communities Select Committee be renamed the Countryside, Culture and Communities Select Committee.
- c) Delegate authority to the Monitoring Officer to amend the Constitution to give effect to the recommendation at b) of this report.
